The Hemostasis and Thrombosis Research Society (HTRS – <u>www.htrs.org</u>) is now accepting applications from residents and fellows to attend the following educational activity:

Applicant Eligibility Requirements

This Workshop is open to **30 MDs or DOs in training** (residents or fellows) interested in building careers in hemostasis and/or thrombosis in pediatric or adult medicine. If there are more than 30 competitive applications, preference will be given to applicants who have not previously attended an HTRS Trainee Workshop.

Workshop Description

This non-CME educational Workshop will be held from April 2-3, 2024. The goal of the Workshop is to attract trainees to the field to benefit current and future patients with hemostatic and thrombotic disorders. The program is a dynamic mix of case presentations by attending trainees, interactive presentations by faculty, small group breakout sessions, and time for networking and mentoring.

The scientific content and agenda for this Workshop are designed by the HTRS Trainee Workshop Planning Committee, comprising HTRS physician members specializing in hemostasis and thrombosis. The Committee ensures that the Workshop is free from commercial bias. (Although this Workshop is non-CME, HTRS follows best practices in CME education to plan and coordinate educational content.)

Trainee Workshop Application Process

Please note that the Trainee Workshop application process is slightly different than previous years, when the applicant's Medical Residency Program Director, Fellowship Program Director, or other mentor was required to complete and submit a nomination form on behalf of the applicant.

Now, applicants must complete and submit their own Application Form, including a required Letter of Support from their Medical Residency Program Director, Fellowship Program Director, or other mentor.

The Application Form includes fields to upload the following components:

- 1. Letter of Support. A letter from the applicant's Medical Residency Program Director, Fellowship Program Director, or other mentor should explain in <u>500 words or less</u> why the applicant is a good candidate for this Workshop.
- 2. **Candidate's Statement**. The applicant should explain in <u>500 words or less</u> why attending this Workshop is important to his/her career plans.
- 3. The applicant's NIH Biosketch or Curriculum Vitae
- 4. The applicant's professional headshot or photograph (ideal sizing 200px x 200px)
- 5. The applicant's professional bio (500 words or less)
- 6. OPTIONAL: An interesting clinical case to be considered for oral presentation during the "Trainee Case Presentations" Session. A popular feature of this Workshop is a session wherein four trainees who are pre-selected by the Planning Committee present an interesting clinical case for discussion. Trainees selected for oral presentation will be paired with a mentor from the Workshop faculty prior to the event.

Notification of Acceptance

All applications will be reviewed by the HTRS Trainee Workshop Planning Committee the week following the application deadline. Applicants will be notified of acceptance via email by early March.

Expenses Reimbursed by HTRS

HTRS will reimburse up to \$750.00 USD total for the following expenses, with receipts, up to 30 days following the Workshop:

- Round-trip, coach class airline, train, or bus tickets (excludes fare and change fee)
- Ground transportation (taxi, Uber, or Lyft) to and from transportation center and hotel
- Mileage, up to a total of 1,215 miles at the standard federal rate of \$0.655/mile
- Daily parking fees, not to exceed \$50.00 USD per day for two (2) days

- Meal per diem for two (2) days, with up to \$65.00 USD per day, only on travel days with receipts. Note that HTRS cannot reimburse meals purchased in lieu of those provided during the meeting.
- Attendees must make their own travel arrangements. Any travel costs exceeding the maximum reimbursement amount of \$750.00 USD are at the attendee's own expense.

Disclosure of Compliance and Reporting Under Open Payments: The Physician Payments Sunshine Act

This educational activity is deemed reportable by law under *Open Payments: The Physician Payments Sunshine Act* ("Sunshine Act"). It is possible that HTRS may be required to share the names and institutional affiliations of participating physicians (both attendees and faculty) at the request of our pharmaceutical company sponsors. Therefore, it is the responsibility of individual attendees to know if their institution mandates specific restrictions regarding the Sunshine Act, as regulations differ by state.
